### **Class Five: Clothing Sewing Basics**

**February 3rd OR March 30th 6 – 9pm**

As your introduction to world of clothing sewing you will sew a pair of pyjama bottoms. You will learn about seam allowances, hems, casings, seam finishes and pattern reading.
